Abstract:

Teaching English in this changing reality can be very challenging. To better address our students’ needs in our in-person, hybrid and asynchronous lessons, we need to think out of the box and provide them with effective feedback that will facilitate their learning. At the end of this workshop, you will identify several feedback tools that can be used in a variety of contexts, as well as a diversified set of strategies to apply them in your classroom.

Workshop Objective:

By the end of the workshop, participants will be able to evaluate online feedback tools identifying at least three options applicable to their contexts.

Tool	Tutorial	Description / Uses
Comments / Google Docs	https://bit.ly/3QCgOLF	Write comments on students’ papers, add @ to tag students. Students can collaborate and provide peer feedback.
Voice Typing / Google Docs	https://bit.ly/3caTrKb	Support students’ pronunciation with immediate feedback. Teachers can check history to verify students’ mistakes.
Rubric / Google Forms	https://bit.ly/3whWdnz	Provide immediate feedback to students’ performance either Spoken or Written work. It can work for self-assessment and peer evaluation.
Rubric / Google Classroom	https://bit.ly/3pxXjYK	Create, reuse and upload rubrics.

Peer Feedback/ Google Forms	https://bit.ly/3c2W9S4	Using a rubric, students can provide feedback to their climates using different criteria.
Peer Feedback / Loom	https://bit.ly/3R0cPZg	Students and teachers can use emoticons, text, audio and video to comment on others' videos.
Peer Feedback/ Flip	https://bit.ly/3whMygQ	Students can enter the classes and see the list of topics. They share videos and they can comment on classmates' videos.
